### 1. **Measure the Whole Room**

Begin by outlining the room on the grid below. Include anything permanent such as door and window measurements.

### 2. **Draw Out Your Project**

Next, use the grid to design the cupboards or shelving for your room. Make sure to include appropriate measurements such as:

- Appliance Sizes
- Corner to end of cabinets
- Ceiling Height
- Size and placement of Windows and Doors


